◦ Change in Assessments

- A new grading system
- Reagan only has 3 yrs. of a new grading systems.

◦ Goals

- to meet a set of learning objectives.
- If student meets or exceeds the learning objectives they should be rewarded.

◦ Compliance

- teachers rewarded students who were cooperative.
- these people/students weren't that successful in college/work place.

◦ Assessments

- Two types of assessment
 - Practice
 - Evidence

◦ Practice

- Practice prepares you for mastery of the objects.
- Multiple opportunities
 - oral participation, debates...

◦ Evidence

- demonstrate your mastery of objects
 - test, quizzes, projects...

Evidence Score

- AD - advance, exceptional mastery
- PR - Proficient, good mastery
- BA - Basic, beginning mastery
- MI - minimal, no evidence of mastery
- O - no evidence, no evidence

New Assessments

- Under the new system the only interest is your final level of mastery

Final Grades

- Each semester is 18 weeks
- Your grades will reflect what you have done
- After 9 weeks you get an update but your grade won't be renewed
